## Presenters

**Keynote speaker - Professor Eishi Yoshinobu, Tokyo Medical and Dental University**

Professor Eishi completed his medical degrees in Japan. In 1989 he was awarded a PhD from the John Curtin School of Medical Research at ANU for studies in self tolerance to thyroid determinants. He is a clinical pathologist with research interests in immunology, anatomical pathology, bacteriology, internal medicine, and collagen and infectious diseases. He has published extensively in the fields of lung cancer and interstitial lung diseases.

**Sarcoidosis case studies - lead presenter Dr Geoff Kemp**

Dr Geoff Kemp is a Melbourne General Practitioner. He introduced McPherson Brown protocols for the treatment of connective tissue diseases in the mid 1990s and commenced treating a wider range of patients under the Marshall Protocol in 2005. He has co-authored two medical journal papers on the links between putative chronic rickettsial infections and autoimmune and other inflammatory conditions.
